Accommodation and Facilities

Longlands is split over two floors, with 43 bedrooms, all of which are en-suite and decorated to a high standard. We also encourage residents to bring their own furnishings to make their room feel as homely as possible.

Inside the home, there are three comfortable lounges along with a conservatory which overlooks our pleasant enclosed gardens complete

with established plants, shrubs and our own apple tree, two dining rooms serving fresh home cooked food, hairdressing salon and ample parking for visitors.

We also offer a personal laundry service for all residents and as well as a hairdresser who attends weekly, we also have regular visits from an optician, dentist and chiropodist.*

Activities

Our two Activity Coordinators provide a wide range of activities designed to encourage group involvement and also to meet individual needs, but the choice to participate rests solely with our residents.

Each day is different, but activities include bingo, dominoes, reminiscence, arts and crafts, exercise classes, race nights, pamper nights, coffee mornings and outings* to local markets and shops and also local places of interest.

We also encourage visits* from local entertainers, such as choirs, singers, and groups.

When it comes to devising activities, we are continually thinking outside the box, so you are just as likely to see residents playing a game of life size Hungry Hippos or in the garden throwing a giant inflatable ball to each other.
