Roseleigh is a purpose-built home, providing residential care for up to 50 residents. This includes long-term, short-term and respite care, as well as specialist care for people with complex needs such as dementia and physical disabilities.



Set in a quiet part of Middlesbrough, close to the town centre and accessed from one of the town's historic cobbled streets, our home is one of the few residential settings awarded a fivestar rating from Middlesbrough Borough Council. Care is provided by a highly qualified, long-serving staff team who are committed to providing unrivalled person-centred care, ensuring our residents are safe, happy and comfortable in the home at all times.

Accommodation and Facilities

Roseleigh is split over two floors, with the second floor allocated to residents with dementia/ alzheimer's who require more specialist support, such as help with meals, personal care, and medications. This floor includes themed corridors designed to stimulate the senses.

There are two large, comfortable lounges in the home, along with a smaller lounge which is ideal for residents to meet* with family members or just have some quiet, personal time away from their room.

In addition, we have three dining rooms serving fresh home cooked food, a garden room and beautiful spacious, enclosed garden with established plants and shrubs. There's also a shop, hairdressing salon and ample parking for visitors.

All of our rooms are en-suite and decorated to a high standard. We encourage residents to bring their own furnishings to make their room feel as homely as possible.

Activities

Our two Activity Coordinators provide a wide range of activities designed to encourage group involvement and also to meet individual needs, but the choice to participate rests solely with our residents.

Each day is different, but activities include bingo, dominoes, reminiscence, arts and crafts, exercise classes, race nights, pamper nights, coffee mornings and outings* to local markets and shops and also local places of interest.

We also encourage visits* from local entertainers, such as choirs, singers, and groups.

When it comes to devising activities, we are continually thinking outside the box, so you are just as likely to see residents playing a game of life size Hungry Hippos or in the garden throwing a giant inflatable ball to each other.
