Queen's Lodge is a purpose-built home, providing residential and nursing care for up to 40 residents. This includes long-term, short-term, respite and nursing care.



Located at Haslingden Road, Blackburn, just minutes off the M65, our home is rated as Good by the Care Quality Commission.

Care is provided by a highly qualified, long-serving staff team who are committed to providing unrivalled person-centred care, ensuring our residents are safe, happy and comfortable in the home at all times.

Accommodation and Facilities

Queen's Lodge is split over two floors, with 34 bedrooms (including 6 twin rooms), all of which are en-suite. We encourage residents to bring their own furnishings to make their room feel as homely as possible.

Inside the home, there are five comfortable lounges, library, a large open plan dining room serving fresh home-cooked food, hairdressing salon and conservatory overlooking our

pleasant enclosed gardens with well-maintained lawns, flower beds, trees, seating area and even our own duck pond.

We also offer a personal laundry service for all residents and as well as a hairdresser who attends weekly, we also have regular visits from an optician, dentist and chiropodist*. There is also ample parking for visitors.

Activities

We provide a wide range of activities designed to encourage group involvement but also to meet individual needs, however the choice to participate rests solely with our residents.

Each day is different, but activities include bingo, dominoes, reminiscence, arts and crafts, exercise classes, race nights, pamper evenings, coffee mornings and outings* to local markets and shops and also local places of interest.

We also encourage visits* from local entertainers, such as choirs, singers, and groups.

When it comes to devising activities, we are continually thinking outside the box, so you are just as likely to see residents playing a game of life size Hungry Hippos or throwing a giant inflatable ball to each other in the garden.

Nursing Care

Queen’s Lodge is a care home with nursing care, which means we are able to support people who need 24-hour support and/or regular care tasks carried out. This can include all aspects of daily living, personal care, wound care and administration of medication.

We can also support people with specialist care needs, such as Percutaneous Endoscopic Gastrostomy (PEG) feeding, cancer care, brain/head injury, motor neurone disease and multiple sclerosis.

Nursing end of life care is also provided.

Our nursing care is delivered by highly qualified registered nurses supported by a team of care assistants.



Respite Care

Respite care enables carers to ensure their loved ones receive the help and support they need whilst they take a break from their roles. It’s also a great way to introduce a loved one to residential care and in our experience, having spent time in our home, it often helps them to realise that this is the best and safest place for them.
